

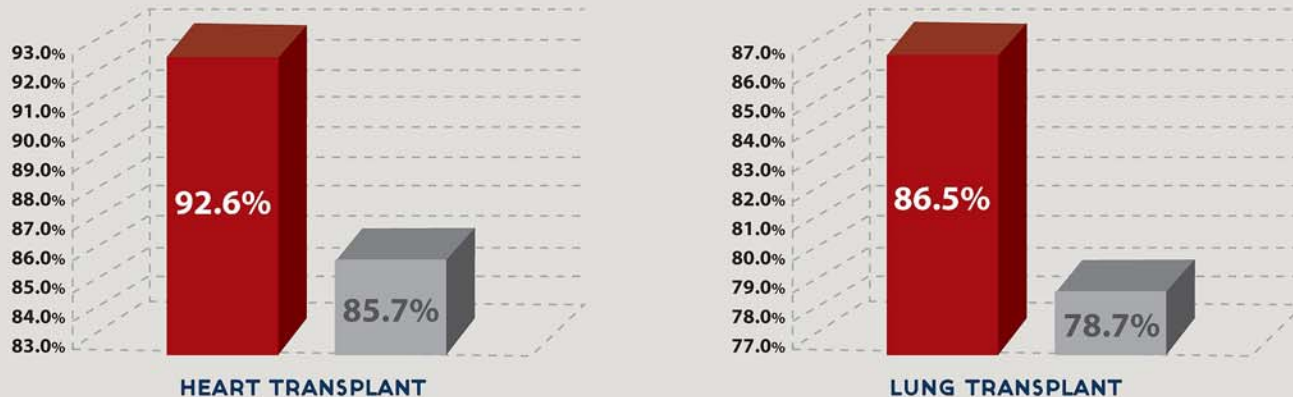

Aliyah Davis, age 17, is the youngest patient in Indiana to have an **implantable ventricular assist device**. Aliyah started college at Purdue University in the fall of 2005 with an artificial heart, six months following the implant.
